

ABC's of Prayer

Prayer is:

KNOWING what Yahuah has said

BELIEVING Yahuah will do what he has said

TRUSTING Yahuah to do what he has said

Heb 11:1 Now faith is the **substance** of things hoped for, the **evidence** of things not seen.

ABC's

ASK – Mt.7:7 Ask and ye shall receive...

BELIEVE – MK.11:24 Therefore I say unto you, What things so-ever ye desire, when ye pray, **believe** that ye receive *them*, and **ye shall have them**.

CLAIM or RECEIVE – JN.11:41 Then they took away the stone *from the place* where the dead was laid. And Yahushua lifted up *his* eyes, said, **Father, I thank thee ...thou hast heard me.**

YAHUAH IS: Eager, Truthful

Eager

Luk 11:9 And **I say unto you, Ask**, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you.

Luk 11:10 For **every one that asketh receiveth**; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Luk 11:11 **If a son shall ask** bread of any of you that is a father, will he give him a stone? or if *he ask* a fish, will he for a fish give him a serpent?

Luk 11:12 Or if he shall ask an egg, will he offer him a scorpion?

Lk.11:13 **If ye then, being evil**, know how to give good gifts unto your children: **how much more** shall *your* **heavenly Father** give the Holy Spirit to **them** that ask him?

Rom.8:32 Who *is* he that condemneth? *It is* Messiah that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of **Yah**, who also maketh intercession for us.

Truthful Num.23:19 Yah *is* not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do *it*? or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?

Mt.24:35 Heaven & earth shall pass away, but **my words shall not pass.**

Heb.6:18 That by two immutable things, in which *it was impossible for Yah* to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us.

YOU MUST HAVE: Childlike faith, Visualize the answer

Childlike faith Mt.18:3 And said, Verily I say unto you, Except ye be **converted**, and **become as little children**, ye shall not enter into the kingdom of heaven.

Heb.11:6 But without faith *it is impossible to please him:* for he that cometh to **Yah** must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Visualize answer Lk.8:11 Now the parable is this: The **seed** is the **word** of **YAH**.

By Faith

Heb 11:1 Now faith is the **substance** of things hoped for, the **evidence** of things not seen.

Heb 11:2 For by it the elders obtained a good report.

Heb 11:3 Through faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of Aluahim, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

Heb 11:4 By faith Abel offered unto Aluahim a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, Aluahim testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh.

Heb 11:5 By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because Aluahim had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

Heb 11:6 **But without faith *it is impossible to please him:* for he that cometh to Aluahim must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.**

Heb 11:7 By faith Noah, being warned of Aluahim of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.

Heb 11:8 By faith Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went.

Heb 11:9 By faith he sojourned in the land of promise, as *in* a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:

Heb 11:10 For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker *is* Aluahim.

Heb 11:11 Through faith also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, because she judged him faithful who had promised.

Heb 11:12 Therefore sprang there even of one, and him as good as dead, *so many* as the stars of the sky in multitude, and as the sand which is by the sea shore innumerable.

Heb 11:13 These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of *them*, and embraced *them*, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

Heb 11:14 For they that say such things declare plainly that they seek a country.

Heb 11:15 And truly, if they had been mindful of that *country* from whence they came out, they might have had opportunity to have returned.

Heb 11:16 But now they desire a better *country*, that is, an heavenly: wherefore Aluahim is not ashamed to be called their Aluahim: for he hath prepared for them a city.

Heb 11:17 By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten *son*,

Heb 11:18 Of whom it was said, That in Isaac shall thy seed be called:

Heb 11:19 Accounting that Aluahim *was* able to raise *him* up, even from the dead; from whence also he received him in a figure.

Heb 11:20 By faith Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come.

Heb 11:21 By faith Jacob, when he was a dying, blessed both the sons of Joseph; and worshipped, *leaning* upon the top of his staff.

Heb 11:22 By faith Joseph, when he died, made mention of the departing of the children of Israel; and gave commandment concerning his bones.

Heb 11:23 By faith Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw *he was* a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment.

Heb 11:24 By faith Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of

Pharaoh's daughter;

Heb 11:25 Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of Aluahim, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;

Heb 11:26 Esteeming the reproach of Mashiach greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompence of the reward.

Heb 11:27 By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.

Heb 11:28 Through faith he kept the passover, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them.

Heb 11:29 By faith they passed through the Red sea as by dry *land*: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned.

Heb 11:30 By faith the walls of Jericho fell down, after they were compassed about seven days.

Heb 11:31 By faith the harlot Rahab perished not with them that believed not, when she had received the spies with peace.

Heb 11:32 And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and of Barak, and of Samson, and of Jephthae; of David also, and Samuel, and of the prophets:

Heb 11:33 Who through faith subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, stopped the mouths of lions,

Heb 11:34 Quenched the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens.

Heb 11:35 Women received their dead raised to life again: and others were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection:

Heb 11:36 And others had trial of *cruel* mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds and imprisonment:

Heb 11:37 They were stoned, they were sawn asunder, were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented;

Heb 11:38 (Of whom the world was not worthy:) they wandered in deserts, and *in* mountains, and *in* dens and caves of the earth.

Heb 11:39 And these all, having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise:

Heb 11:40 Aluahim having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.

1Chr 4:9 And Jabez was more honourable than his brethren: and his mother called his name Jabez, saying, Because I bare him with sorrow.

1Chr 4:10 And Jabez called on the God of Israel, saying, Oh that thou wouldest bless me indeed, and enlarge my coast, and that thine hand might be with me, and that thou wouldest keep *me* from evil, that it may not grieve me! And God granted him that which he requested.
