

DEATH #12

When a man dies what happens to him? Where does he go? What about our deceased loved ones? Scripture teaching on death is consistent, NOT confusing. There may be some surprises. Its answers are reasonable, satisfying and comforting.

Q.1 How did Yahusha refer to death?

Ans. John 11:11-14

Q.2 How does the 1st Testament refer to death?

Ans. Deut.31:14-16; 2 Sam.7:12

Q.3 How did Paul understand death & the resurrection?

Ans. 1 Thes.4:15,16; Acts 13:36

Q.4 How did Daniel understand death & the resurrection?

Ans. Daniel 12:2

Q.5 What did Yahusha teach - death & the resurrection?

Ans. John 5:28,29

Q.6 Who alone is immortal?

Ans. 1 Tim.6:15,16; 1 Tim.1:17

Q.7 How is man described cp. With Yahuah?

Ans. Romans 1:23

Q.8 At what point does man become immortal?

Ans. 1 Cor.15:51-54

Note: Scripture describes death as 'sleep' over 50 times. In order to understand death we must 1st understand life.

Q.9 What 2 elements did Yahuah combine to make man a living soul?

Ans. Gen.2:7

Q.10 How is the process Yahuah used in creating a soul reversed when we die? Ans.

Ans. Psalm 104:29

Q.11 Can a soul die?

Ans. Ezekiel 18:20

Q.12 When life ends, what is left?

Ans. Genesis 3:19

Q.13 How does Scripture define 'live?'

Ans. Job 27:3

Q.14 What happens when the breath returns to Yahuah?

Ans. Job 14:10-12

Note: Yahuah did NOT PUT a living soul into Adam. Adam BECAME a living soul as a result of Yahuah putting the *body* and *breath* (or *spirit*) from Yahuah.

Illustration:

Dust & Breath = Living soul

Soul – Breath = Dust

Q.15 How much does a man know when he is dead?

Ans. Ecc.9:5,6,10

Q.16 Can the dead Praise Yahuah?

Ans. Psalm 115:17

Q.17 Can a dead person return to his home as a 'departed spirit' or ghost?

Ans. Job 7:9,10

Conclusion: When a man dies he does NOT live somewhere else. He is NOT in heaven, NOT in hell, NOT in purgatory. He is NOT alive at all, anywhere, in ANY condition. He is in a state of sleep or unconsciousness. The dead rest quietly in the grave UNTIL Yahusha returns.
