How to obtain -

Rom 10:17 So then faith *cometh* by hearing, and hearing by the word of **Elohim**.

What is it -

1. **Knowing** what Yah has said He WILL DO
2. **Believing** Yah WILL DO what he has promised
3. **Expecting** Yah TO DO what He has promised to do

What is it in essence - Heb 11:1

How to prepare (Armour) -

Eph 6:10-18 Finally, my brethren, be strong in **YaHuah**, and in the power of his might.

Eph 6:11 Put on the whole armour of **Yah**, that ye may be able to stand against the **wiles of the devil**.

Eph 6:12 For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*.

Eph 6:13 Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of **Yah**, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Eph 6:14 Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with **truth**, and having on the breastplate of **righteousness**;

Eph 6:15 And your feet shod with the preparation of the **gospel of Shalom**;

Eph 6:16 Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

Eph 6:17 And take the **helmet** of salvation, and the **sword** of the Spirit, which is the word of **Yah**:

Eph 6:18 Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints.

By Faith

Heb 11:1 Now **faith** is the **substance** of things hoped for, the **evidence** of things not seen.

Heb 11:2 For **by it** the elders obtained a good report.

Heb 11:3 **Through faith** we understand that the worlds were framed by the **word of Yah**, so that things which are seen were not made of things which do appear.

Heb 11:4 **By faith** Abel offered unto **Yah** a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, **by which** he obtained witness that he was righteous, **Yah** testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh.

Heb 11:5 **By faith** Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because **Yah** had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased **Yah**.

Heb 11:6 But without faith *it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to Yah must believe that he is, and *that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.**

Heb 11:7 **By faith** Noah, being warned of **Yah** of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is **by faith**.

Heb 11:8 **By faith** Abraham, when he was called to go out into a place which he should after receive for an inheritance, **obeyed; and he went out, not knowing whither he went.**

Heb 11:9 **By faith** he sojourned in the land of promise, as *in* a strange country, dwelling in tabernacles with Isaac and Jacob, the heirs with him of the same promise:

Heb 11:10 For he looked for a city which hath foundations, whose builder and maker *is* **Yah**.

Heb 11:11 Through faith also Sara herself received strength to conceive seed, and was delivered of a child when she was past age, **because she judged him faithful who had promised.**

Heb 11:12 Therefore sprang there even of one, and him as good as dead, *so many* as the stars of the sky in multitude, and as the sand which is by the sea shore innumerable.

Num.23:19 Yah is not a man, that he should lie; neither the son of man, that he should repent: hath he said, and shall he not do *it?* or hath he spoken, and shall he not make it good?

Mt.24:35 Heaven & earth shall pass away, but my words shall not pass.

Heb.6:18 That by two immutable things, in which *it was impossible for Yah* to lie, we might have a strong consolation, who have fled for refuge to lay hold upon the hope set before us.

Heb 11:13 These all died in faith, not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off, and were persuaded of *them*, and embraced *them*, and confessed that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth.

Heb 11:14 For they that say such things declare plainly that they seek a country.

Heb 11:15 And truly, if they had been mindful of that *country* from whence they came out, they might have had opportunity to have returned.

Heb 11:16 But now they desire a better *country*, that is, an heavenly: wherefore **Yah** is not ashamed to be called their **Yah**: for he hath prepared for them a city.

Heb 11:17 By faith Abraham, when he was tried, offered up Isaac: and he that had received the promises offered up his only begotten *son*,

Heb 11:18 Of whom it was said, That in Isaac shall thy seed be

called:

Heb 11:19 Accounting that Yah was able to raise *him up, even from the dead*; from whence also he received him in a figure.

Heb 11:20 **By faith** Isaac blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come.

Heb 11:21 **By faith** Jacob, when he was a dying, blessed both the sons of Joseph; and worshipped, *leaning* upon the top of his staff.

Heb 11:22 By faith Joseph, when he died, made mention of the departing of the children of Israel; and gave commandment concerning his bones.

Heb 11:23 **By faith** Moses, when he was born, was hid three months of his parents, because they saw *he was* a proper child; and they were not afraid of the king's commandment.

Heb 11:24 **By faith** Moses, when he was come to years, refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter;

Heb 11:25 Choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of **Yah**, than to enjoy the pleasures of sin for a season;

Heb 11:26 Esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt: for he had respect unto the recompence of the reward.

Heb 11:27 **By faith** he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king: for he endured, as seeing him who is invisible.

Heb 11:28 **Through faith** he **kept the passover**, and the sprinkling of blood, lest he that destroyed the firstborn should touch them.

Heb 11:29 **By faith** they passed through the Red sea as by dry *land*: which the Egyptians assaying to do were drowned.

Heb 11:30 **By faith** the walls of **Jericho** fell down, after they were compassed about seven days.

Heb 11:31 **By faith** the harlot Rahab perished not with them

that believed not, when she had received the spies with peace.

Heb 11:32 And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of **Gedeon**, and of **Barak**, and of **Samson**, and of **Jephthae**; of **David** also, and **Samuel**, and of the **prophets**:

Heb 11:33 Who **through faith** subdued kingdoms, wrought righteousness, obtained promises, **stopped** the mouths of lions, **Daniel 6:22**.

Heb 11:34 **Quenched** the violence of fire, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, turned to flight the armies of the aliens. **Daniel 3:8**

Heb 11:35 **Women** received their dead raised to life again: and **others** were tortured, not accepting deliverance; that they might obtain a better resurrection:

Heb 11:36 And **others** had trial of *cruel* mockings and scourgings, yea, moreover of bonds and imprisonment:

Heb 11:37 They were **stoned**, they were **sawn asunder**, were **tempted**, were **slain** with the sword: they **wandered** about in sheepskins and goatskins; being **destitute, afflicted, tormented**.

See 2 Cor.1:3-11

2Co 1:3 Blessed *be* **Yah**, even the Father of our Sovereign YaHuShua ha Mashiach, the Father of mercies, and the **Yah** of all comfort;

2Co 1:4 Who **comforteth** us in all our tribulation, that we may be able to comfort them which are in any trouble, by the comfort wherewith we ourselves are comforted of **Yah**.

2Co 1:5 For as the sufferings of Mashiach abound in us, so our consolation also aboundeth by Mashiach.

2Co 1:6 And whether we be afflicted, *it is* for your consolation and salvation, which is effectual in the enduring of the same sufferings which we also suffer: or whether we be comforted, *it is* for your consolation and salvation.

2Co 1:7 And our **hope** of you *is* stedfast, knowing, that as ye are

partakers of the sufferings, so *shall ye be* also of the consolation.

2Co 1:8 For we would not, brethren, have you ignorant of our trouble which came to us in Asia, that we were **pressed out** of measure, **above strength**, insomuch that we **despaired** even of life:

2Co 1:9 But we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves, but in **Yah** which raiseth the dead:

2Co 1:10 **Who delivered us from so great a death, and doth deliver: in whom we trust that he will yet deliver us;**

2Co 1:11 Ye also helping together by prayer for us, that for the gift *bestowed* upon us by the means of many persons thanks may be given by many on our behalf.

Heb 11:38 (Of whom the world was not worthy:) they wandered in deserts, and *in* mountains, and *in* dens and caves of the earth.

Heb 11:39 And these all, **having obtained a good report through faith, received not the promise:**

Heb 11:40 **Yah** having provided some better thing for us, that they without us should not be made perfect.

Isa 26:2 Open ye the gates, that the **righteous** nation which **keepeth the truth** may enter in.

Isa 26:3 **Thou wilt keep *him* in perfect peace, *whose* mind is stayed on thee: because he trusteth in thee.**

Isa 26:4 **Trust ye in **Yahuah** for ever: for in Sovereign **Yahuah** *is* everlasting strength...**
