

Key Knowledge

Lk.11:52 Woe unto you, **lawyers!** for ye have **taken away the key of knowledge:** ye entered not in yourselves, and them that were entering in ye **hindered.** **Mt.23:13**

Lk.19:41-44 And when he was come near, he beheld the **city,** (Jerusalem) and wept over it,

Lk.19:42 Saying, **If** thou hadst **known,** even thou, at least in this thy day, the things *which belong* unto thy peace! but now they are **hid from thine eyes.** **See Jer.16:19**

Lk.19:43 For the days shall come upon thee, that thine enemies shall **cast a trench** about thee, and **compass thee round,** and **keep thee** in on every side, **70-AD**

Lk.19:44 And shall **lay** thee even with the ground, and thy children within thee; and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; because thou **knewest not the time of thy visitation.** **Amos 3:7**

Hos.4:1 Hear the word of YAHUAH, ye children of Israel: for YAHUAH hath a **controversy** with the inhabitants of the land, **because *there is no truth, nor mercy, nor knowledge of Elohim*** (His Torah/Ways) in the land.

***Mic 6:8** He hath **shewed thee,** O man, **what is good;** and what doth YAHUAH ***require** of thee, but to **do justly,** and to **love mercy,** and to **walk humbly with thy Elohim?** **Jas.2:13**

***Hos.4:2** By **swearing,** and **lying,** and **killing,** and **stealing,** and **committing adultery,** they break out, and **blood toucheth blood.** **1Cor.6:9,10**

Hos.4:3 Therefore shall the land mourn, and **every one** that dwelleth therein shall languish, with the beasts of the field, and with the fowls of heaven; yea, the fishes of the sea also **shall be taken away**.

Hos.4:4 Yet let no man strive, nor reprove another: for thy people *are* as they that strive with the priest.

Hos.4:5 Therefore shalt thou fall in the day, and the prophet also shall fall with thee in the night, **and I will destroy thy mother** (City; Jerusalem - church). **Mt.7:21-23; Rev.22:14**

Hos.4:6 My people are **destroyed for lack of knowledge: because** thou hast **rejected knowledge**, I will also **reject thee**, that **thou shalt be no priest to me**: seeing thou hast **forgotten the law (Torah) of thy Elohim**, I - also **forget thy children**. Sadly - forgot Torah!

Shechem (/ˈʃekəm/), also spelled **Sichem** (/ˈsɪkəm/; Hebrew: שֵׁכֶם, Modern: *Šekem*, Tiberian: *Šəkem*, lit. 'shoulder'; Ancient Greek: Συχέμ LXX; Samaritan Hebrew:

שֵׁכֶם *Šākēm*), was a Canaanite and Israelite city mentioned in the Amarna Letters, later appearing in the Hebrew Bible as the first capital of the Kingdom of Israel following the split of the United Monarchy.^[1] According to Joshua 21:20–21, it was located in the tribal territorial allotment of the tribe of Ephraim. Shechem declined after the fall of the northern Kingdom of Israel. The city later regained its importance as an prominent Samaritan center during the Hellenistic period.^[2]

Traditionally associated with the city of Nablus,^[3] Shechem is now identified with the nearby site of Tell Balata in the Balata al-Balad suburb of the West Bank.

Knowledge of Yahusha - sitting & hearing

Luk 10:39 And she had a sister called **Mary**, which also **sat at Yahusha's feet**, and **heard his word**.

Luk 10:40 **But Martha** was **cumbered about much serving**, and came to him, and said, Master, dost thou not care that my sister hath left me to **serve alone**? bid her therefore that she help me.

Luk 10:41 And **Yahusha** answered and said unto her, **Martha**,

Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things:

Luk 10:42 But **one thing is needful**: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.

Knowledge of Yahuah's Torah

Mal 2:7 For the priest's lips **should keep knowledge**, and they **should seek** the **Torah** at his mouth: for he *is* the messenger of **Yahuah** of hosts. **Mal.4:4; Mt.5:17-19; Jn.14:15; 15:10; Ex.20:18-21**

Knowledge of Yahusha's origin & he is Elohim

Jn.7:46 The **officers** answered, Never man spake like this man.

Jn.7:47 Then answered them - **Pharisees**, Are ye - **deceived**?

Jn.7:48 Have any of the rulers or of the Pharisees believed on him?

Jn.7:49 But this people who **knoweth not** the law are cursed.

Jn.7:50 **Nicodemus** saith unto them, (he that came to **Yahusha** by night, being one of them,)

Jn.7:51 Doth our law judge *any* man, before it hear him, and **know** what he doeth?

Jn.7:52 They answered and said unto him, Art thou also of Galilee? Search, and look: for out of Galilee ariseth no prophet.

Jn.9:24 Then again called they the man that was blind, and said unto him, Give Elohim the praise: **we know** that this man is a sinner.

Jn.9:25 He answered and said, **Whether he be a sinner or no, I know not: one thing I know**, that, whereas I was blind, now I see.

Jn.9:26 Then said they to him again, **What did he to thee?** how opened he thine eyes?

Jn.9:27 He answered them, I have told you already, and ye did

not hear: wherefore would ye hear *it* again? will ye also be his disciples? **John 14:11 ...or else believe me for - very works' sake.**

Jn.9:28 Then they **reviled** him, and said, **Thou art his disciple; but we are Moses' disciples.**

***Jn.5:46 For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me: for he wrote of me.**

Jn.9:29 We **know** that Elohim spake unto Moses: *as for this fellow*, we **know not** from whence he is.

Jn.9:30 The man answered and said unto them, Why herein is a marvellous thing, that ye **know not** from whence he is, and yet he hath opened mine eyes.

Jn.9:31 Now we **know** that Elohim **heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of Elohim, and doeth his will, him he heareth.**

Jn.9:32 Since the world began was it not heard that any man opened the eyes of one that was born blind.

Jn.9:33 If this man were not of Elohim, he could do nothing.

Jn.9:34 They answered and said unto him, Thou wast altogether born in sins, and dost thou teach us? And they cast him out.

Act 4:16 Saying, What shall we do to these men? for that indeed a notable miracle hath been done by them *is* manifest to all them that dwell in Jerusalem; and **we cannot deny it.**

Act 4:17 But that it spread no further among the people, let us straitly threaten them, **that they speak henceforth to no man in this name.** (denies me)

Act 4:18 And they called them, and commanded them not to speak at all nor teach in the name of Yahusha.

Act 4:19 But Peter and John answered and said unto them, Whether it be right in the sight of Elohim to hearken unto you more than unto Elohim, judge ye.

Act 4:20 For - cannot but speak - which we have seen - heard.

The Apostles Arrested and Freed

Act 5:40 And to him they agreed: **and when they had called the apostles, and beaten *them*, they commanded that they should not speak in the name of Yahusha, and let them go.**

Act 5:17 Then the **high priest** rose up, and all they that were with him, (which is **the sect of the Sadducees,**) and **were filled with indignation,**

Act 5:18 **And laid their hands on the apostles, and put them in the common prison.**

Act 5:19 But the angel of **Yahuah** by night opened the prison doors, and brought them forth, and said,

Act 5:20 **Go, stand and speak in the temple to the people all the words of this life.**

Act 5:21 And when they heard *that*, they entered into the temple early in the morning, and taught. **But the high priest** came, and they that were with him, and **called the council together, and all the senate** of the children of Israel, and sent to the prison to have them brought. (con't)

Ps.2:1 **Why** do the heathen rage, and the people **imagine** a vain thing?

Ps.2:2 The **kings** of the earth set themselves, and the **rulers** take **counsel** together, against YAHUAH, and against his anointed, *saying,*

Ps.2:3 Let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us.

Eze 22:25 *There is* a **conspiracy** of her prophets in the midst thereof, like a roaring lion **ravening** the prey; they have **de-voured** souls; they have taken the **treasure and precious things**; they have **made her many widows** in the midst thereof. Mat 13:45 **Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto a**

merchant man, seeking goodly pearls:

Mat 13:46 Who, when he had found one pearl of great price, went and sold all that he had, and bought it.

2Chr.16:9 For the eyes of YAHUAH run to and fro throughout the whole earth, to shew himself strong in the behalf of *them* whose heart *is* perfect toward him. Herein thou hast done foolishly: therefore from henceforth thou shalt have wars.

Pro 20:15 There is gold, and a multitude of rubies: **but the lips of knowledge are a precious jewel.**

Act 5:22 But when the **officers** came, and found them not in the prison, they returned, and told,

Act 5:23 Saying, The prison truly found we shut with all safety, and the keepers standing without before the doors: but when we had opened, we found no man within.

Act 5:24 Now when the **high priest** and the **captain of the**

temple and the **chief priests** heard these things, they doubted of them whereunto this would grow.

Act 5:25 Then came one and told them, saying, Behold, the men whom ye put in prison are standing in the temple, and teaching the people.

Act 5:26 Then went the captain with the officers, and brought them without violence: for they feared the people, lest they should have been stoned.

Act 5:27 And when they had brought them, they set *them* before the council: and the high priest asked them,

Act 5:28 Saying, Did not we straitly command you that ye should not teach **in this name**? and, behold, ye have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this man's blood upon us.

Act 5:29 Then Peter and the *other* apostles answered and said, We ought to obey Elohim rather than men.

Act 5:30 The Elohim of our fathers raised up Yahusha, whom ye slew and hanged on a tree.

Act 5:31 Him hath Elohim exalted with his right hand *to be* a Prince and a Saviour, - give repentance to Israel, and forgiveness - sins.

Act 5:32 And we are his witnesses of these things; and *so is* also the Holy Spirit, whom Elohim hath **given** to them that **obey him**.

Act 5:33 When they heard *that*, they were cut *to the heart*, and took counsel to slay them.

Act 5:34 Then stood there up one in the council, a Pharisee, named **Gamaliel**, a doctor of the law, had in reputation among all the people, and commanded to put the apostles forth a little space;

Act 5:35 And said unto them, Ye men of Israel, take heed to yourselves what ye intend to do as touching these men.

Act 5:36 For before these days rose up Theudas, boasting himself to be somebody; to whom a number of men, about four hundred, joined themselves: who was slain; and all, as many as obeyed him, were scattered, and brought to nought.

Act 5:37 After this man rose up Judas of Galilee in the days of the taxing, and drew away much people after him: he also perished; and

all, *even* as many as obeyed him, were dispersed.

Act 5:38 And now I say unto you, **Refrain from these men, and let them alone: for if this counsel or this work be of men, it will come to nought:**

Act 5:39 **But if it be of Elohim, ye cannot overthrow it; lest haply ye be found even to fight against Elohim.**

Act 5:40 And to him they agreed: and when they had called the apostles, and beaten *them*, they commanded that they should not speak in the name of **Yahusha**, and let them go.

Act 5:41 And they departed from the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer shame for his name.

Act 5:42 And **daily in the temple, and in every house, they ceased not to teach and preach Yahusha ha Mashiach.**

Luk 10:2 Therefore said he unto them, **The harvest truly is great, but the labourers are few: pray ye therefore the Master of the harvest, that he would send forth labourers into his harvest. Yabez**
