

Knowledge of the Holy

John 3:16 For **Elohim** so **loved** the world, that **HE gave** his **ONLY** begotten Son, that **whosoever believeth** in him should **not perish**, but have everlasting life. **1Pe.1:16**, no one see

John 3:17 For **Elohim** sent not his Son into the world to **condemn** the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

John 3:18 He that **believeth** on him is not condemned: but he that **believeth not** is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the **name** of the only begotten Son of **Elohim**.

John 3:19 And this is the **condemnation**, that light is come into the world, and **men loved darkness rather than light**, because their deeds were evil.

John 3:20 For **every one that doeth evil hateth the light**, neither cometh to the light, lest his deeds should be reprov'd.

John 3:21 But he that doeth truth cometh to the light, that his deeds may be made manifest, that they are wrought in **Elohim**.

John 17:1 **These words spake Yahusha**, and lifted up his eyes to heaven, and said, **Father, the hour is come; glorify thy Son, that thy Son also may glorify thee:**

John 17:2 As thou hast given him power over all flesh, that he should give eternal life to as many as thou hast given him.

***John 17:3** **And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the ONLY TRUE Elohim, and Yahusha haMashiach, whom thou hast sent.**

G1097 γινώσκω ginōskō A prolonged form of a **primary verb**; to "know" (absolutely), in a great variety of applications and with many implications (as shown at left, with others not thus clearly expressed): - allow, **be aware (of), feel, (have) known** (-ledge), **perceive**, be resolved, can speak, be sure, **understand. Total KJV: 223**

John 17:4 I have glorified thee on the earth: **I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do.**

John 17:5 And now, O Father, **glorify thou me with thine own self with the glory which I had with thee before the world was.**

John 17:6 **I have manifested thy name*** unto the men **which thou gavest me out of the world:** thine they were, and thou gavest them me; and they have kept thy word.

○ **Yahusha haMashiach (Sent)**

Rev 14:1 And I looked, and, lo, a **Lamb*** stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty *and* four thousand, **having his Father's name written in their foreheads.** See **Jn.1:29,36**

Pro 30:4 **Who** hath ascended up into heaven, or descended? who hath gathered the wind in his fists? who hath bound the waters in a garment? who hath established all the ends of the earth? **what is his name, and what is his son's name,** if thou canst tell? **See 1Tim 3:16**

Mal 2:2 **If** ye will **not hear,** and **if** ye will **not lay it to heart, to give glory unto my name,** saith **YAHUAH** of hosts, **I will even send a curse upon you, and I will curse your blessings:** yea, I have cursed them already, because ye do not lay *it* to heart. **See Deut.27;28**

Jer 23:26 How long shall *this* be in the heart of the **prophets** that **prophecy lies?** yea, *they are* prophets **of the deceit of their own heart;**

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23:27 Which **think to cause my people to forget my name** by their dreams which they tell every man to his neighbour, **as their fathers have forgotten my name for Baal.**

Exo 33:13 And in all *things* that I have said unto you be circum-spect: and **make no mention of the name of other gods,**

neither let it be heard out of thy mouth.

Isa 52:6 Therefore my people shall know my name: therefore *they shall know* **in that day that I am** he that doth speak: behold, *it is I*.

Jer 16:21 Therefore, behold, I will this once **cause them to know**, I will **cause them to know** mine hand and my might; and **they shall know that my name is YAHUAH**.

John 17:7 Now they have **known** that all things whatsoever thou hast given me are of thee.

John 17:8 For I have **given** unto them the **words** which thou gavest me; and they have **received** *them*, and have **known** surely that I came out from thee, and they have believed that thou didst send me.

Gen 22:7 And **Isaac** spake unto **Abraham** his father, and said, My father: and he said, **Here am I, my son**. And he said, **Behold the fire and the wood: but where is the lamb for a burnt offering?**

Gen 22:8 And Abraham said, **My son, Elohim will provide himself a lamb* for a burnt offering**: so they went both of them together. **See John 1:29,36**

Gen 22:13 And Abraham lifted up his eyes, and looked, and behold behind *him* **a ram caught in a thicket*** by his horns: and Abraham went and took the ram, and offered him up for a burnt offering **in the stead* of his son**.

thicket H5442 סִבְאָה *sebâk seb-awk'* From H5440; a *copse*: -*thick* (-*et*). **Isa.10:34**

Isa.9:18 For **wickedness** burneth as the fire: it shall devour the **briers** and **thorns**, and shall kindle in the **thickets** of the forest, and they shall mount up *like* the lifting up of smoke.

Knowledge of Yahusha - sitting & hearing

Luke 10:39 And she had a sister called **Mary**, which also **sat at Yahusha's feet**, and **heard his word**.

Luke 10:40 **But Martha** was **cumbered about much serving**, and came to him, and said, Master, dost thou not care that my sister hath left me to **serve alone**? bid her therefore that she help me.

Luke 10:41 And **Yahusha** answered and said unto her, **Martha, Martha, thou art careful and troubled about many things:**

Luke 10:42 But **one thing is needful**: and Mary hath chosen that good part, which shall not be taken away from her.

Knowledge of Yahuah's Torah

Mal 2:7 For the priest's lips **should keep knowledge**, and they **should seek the Torah** at his mouth: for he the messenger of **Yahuah** of hosts. **Mt.5:17-19; Jn.14:15; 15:10; Ex.20:18-21**

Mal.4:4 Remember ye the law (**Torah***) of Moses my servant, which I commanded unto him in **Horeb** (Sinai) for all Israel, **with the statutes and judgments**. ***Mt.5:17-19**

Mal 4:5 Behold, **I will send you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the great and dreadful day of YAHUAH.**

H452 אֵלִיָּהוּ אֵלִיָּהוּ 'êlîyâh 'êlîyâhû *ay-lee-yaw', ay-lee-yaw'-hoo* From H410 and H3050; **Elohim of Yahuah**; *Elijah*, the name of the famous prophet and of two other Israelites: - Elijah, Eliah. **Total KJV: 71**

Mal 4:6 And **he shall turn*** the heart of the fathers to the children, and the **heart of the children** to their fathers, lest I come and smite the earth with a curse. (**Voice of One**) **Elijah**

H7725 שׁוּב shûb A **primitive root; to turn back (hence, away)** transitively or intransitively, lit. or fig. (**not necessarily** with the idea of *return* to the starting point); generally to **retreat**; often adverbially *again*: - ([**break, build, circumcise, dig, do anything, do evil, feed, lay down, lie down, lodge, make, rejoice, send, take, weep**]) **Total KJV:**

Knowledge of Yahusha's origin

Jn.9:24 Then again called they the man that was blind, and said unto him, Give Elohim the praise: **we know (Really?)** that this man - a sinner.

Jn.9:25 He answered and said, **Whether he be a sinner or no, I know not: one thing I know**, that, whereas I was blind, now I see.

Jn.9:26 Then said they to him again, **What did he to thee?** how opened he thine eyes?

Jn.9:27 He answered them, I have told you already, and ye did not hear: wherefore would ye hear *it* again? will ye also be his disciples?

John 14:10 **Believest thou not** that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? **the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works.**

John 14:11 **Believe** me that I *am* in the Father, and the Father in me: **or else believe me for the very works' sake.**

Luke 7:22 Then Yahusha answering said unto them, **Go** your way, and tell John what things ye have seen and heard; how that **the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, to the poor the gospel is preached.**

Isa 61:1 The **Spirit** of **YAHUAH** Elohim *is* upon me; because Yahuah hath anointed me to **preach** good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to **bind up** the brokenhearted, to **proclaim** liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to *them that are* bound;

Isa 61:2 To **proclaim** the acceptable year of **YAHUAH**, and the day of vengeance of our Elohim; to comfort all that mourn;

Isa 61:3 To **appoint** unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called trees of righteousness, the planting of **YAHUAH**, that he might be glorified.

Isa 61:4 And they shall **build the old wastes**, they shall raise up the former **desolations**, and they shall **repair the waste cities**, the **desolations** of many generations. **Isa.58:12-14**

Isa 58:12 *And they that shall be of thee shall build the old waste places: thou shalt raise up the foundations of many generations; and thou shalt be called, The repairer of the breach, The restorer of paths to dwell in.*

Isa 58:13 *If thou turn away thy foot from the Sabbath, from doing thy pleasure on my holy day; and call the sabbath a delight, the holy of YAHUAH honourable; and shalt honour him, not doing thine own ways, nor finding thine own pleasure, nor speaking thine own words:*

Isa 58:14 *Then shalt thou delight thyself in YAHUAH; and I will cause thee to ride upon the high places of the earth, and feed thee with the heritage of Jacob thy father: for the mouth of YAHUAH hath spoken it.*

Jn.9:28 Then they **reviled** him, and said, **Thou art his disciple; but we are Moses' disciples.**

***Jn.5:46** **For had ye believed Moses, ye would have believed me: for he wrote of me.**

Q. Where did Moses write of Yahusha?

Deu 18:15 **YAHUAH** thy Elohim will raise up unto thee a Prophet **from** the midst of thee, of thy brethren, **like unto me; unto him ye shall hearken... SHAMA**

Deu 18:18 I will raise them up a Prophet from among their brethren, **like unto thee, and will put my words in his mouth; and he shall speak unto them all that I shall command him.**

Jn.9:29 We **know** that Elohim spake unto Moses: *as for this fellow,* we **know not** from whence he is.

Jn.9:30 The man answered and said unto them, **Why herein is a marvellous thing,** that ye **know not** from whence he is, and yet he hath opened mine eyes.

Jn.9:31 Now we **know** that Elohim **heareth not sinners: but if any man be a worshipper of Elohim, and doeth his will, him he heareth.**

Jn.9:32 Since the world began was it not heard that any man opened the eyes of one that was born blind.

Jn.9:33 **If this man were not - Elohim, - could do nothing.**

Jn.9:34 They answered and said unto him, Thou wast altogether born in sins, and dost thou teach us? And **they cast him out.**

'Messiah spoke in parables both to **warn** the rules and to **teach** those who were willing to obey. Through there blind faith in a corrupt people the people were enslaved.' 'These chains Messiah must break, yet there was a need to speak more plainly to the people.'

Mat 13:45 **Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto a merchant man, seeking goodly pearls:**

Mat 13:46 **Who, when he had found one 'pearl of great price,' went and sold all that he had, and bought it.**

Q. Who is the Merchant Man?

Q. What did the Merchant Man do?

Q. Who are the goodly pearls?

2Chr.16:9 For the **eyes of YAHUAH run to and fro throughout the whole earth,** to shew himself **strong** in the behalf of *them* **whose heart is perfect toward him.** Herein thou hast

done foolishly: therefore from henceforth thou shalt have wars.
