

Ps.11:1 In **Yahuah** put I my trust: how say ye to my soul, 'Flee as a bird to your mountain?'

In today's world - hard to find - real safety **ANYWHERE**.

Countless millions are under constant assault. War, pestilence, fire and flood just to name a few things that assail human beings every day. People are facing dangers everywhere they turn. Where can they turn? Their governments? Local authorities – religious leaders? Unfortunately they search in vain for **HELP** from any and all of these sources.

Q.1 Where can we find a refuge for the times we live in?

Ans. Psalm 90:1; 46:1

Listen to opening words of Moses Prayer:

Ps.90:1 Yahuah, thou hast been our **dwelling place** in **all** generations.

Ps.46:1 Yahuah is our '**refuge & strength**', a very **present help in trouble**.

Q.2 What does the term Present Help mean?

Ans.

Isa 7:14 Therefore **Yahuah** himself shall give you a sign; Behold, a virgin shall conceive, and bear a son, and shall call his name **IMMANUEL**. This is known as a character name of Yahusha. It means (**EI** or **Elohim** or **Yahuah**) and (**Im** Heb. For **WITH**). In an even deeper sense it means '**Yahuah with US to HELP**'

The below Hebrew definition helps us see where this comes from.

H6005 עִמָּנוּאֵל 'imma^nu^e^l From **H5973** and H410 with suffix pronoun inserted; **with us** (is) **Yahuah; Immanuel**, a name of Isaiah's son: - Immanuel.

H5973 with re: fellowship & companionship

What better way for Yahuah to help than to have fellowship and companionship with His creation, just like He did with Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden.

Q.3 What is Yahuah seeking from us?

Ans. Exo 25:8 (Fellowship & Companionship)

Exo 25:8 And let them make me a **sanctuary**; that **'I may DWELL among them.'**

Q.4 What is one example in TORAH?

Ans. Genesis 18

Gen 18:1 And YAHUAH appeared unto him... he sat - the tent door...

Gen 18:2 And he lift up his eyes and **looked**, and, lo, **three men** stood by him: and when he **saw them, he ran to meet them**, and bowed himself toward the ground,

Gen 18:3 My master, if now I have found favour in thy sight, **pass not away**, I pray thee, from thy servant:

Gen 18:4 Let a little **water**, I pray you, be fetched, and wash your feet, and rest yourselves under the tree:

Gen 18:5 And I will fetch a morsel of **bread**, and comfort ye your hearts; after that ye shall pass on: for therefore are ye come to your servant. And they said, So do, as thou hast said.

Gen 18:6 And Abraham hastened into the tent unto Sarah, and said, **Make ready quickly three measures of fine meal**, knead *it*, and **make cakes** upon the hearth. (**3 Loaves - UNLEAVENED**)

Note: Not like the churches bake – Mt.13:33; Lk.13:21

Mt 13:33 Another parable spake he unto them; The kingdom of heaven is like unto leaven, which a **woman** took, and **hid in three measures of meal**, till the whole was leavened. (**ONLY One Church - I know - that bakes 3**

Loaves - SDA)

Gen 18:14 Is any thing too hard for YAHUAH...?

Q.5 Does Yahuah keep secrets from His servants?

Ans. Amos 3:7

Amos 3:7 Surely Yahuah Elohim will do nothing, BUT he revealeth his secret unto His servants the prophets.

Gen 18:16 And **the men rose up from thence, and looked toward Sodom...**

Gen 18:17 And **YAHUAH** said, **Shall I hide from Abraham that thing which I do;**

Gen 18:18 Seeing that Abraham shall surely become a great and mighty nation, and all the nations of the earth shall be blessed in him?

Gen 18:19 For **I know him**, that he will **command** his children and his household after him, and they **shall keep - way (TORAH) of YAHUAH**, to **do justice and judgment**; that **YAHUAH** may bring upon Abraham that which he hath spoken of him.

Gen 18:20 And **YAHUAH** said, Because the cry of Sodom and Gomorrah is great, and because their sin is very grievous;

Gen 18:21 I will go down now, and see whether they have done altogether according to the cry of it, which is come unto me; and if not, I will know.

Then Abraham Intercedes for Sodom Gen 18:22-33

Q.6 Can others see YOUR life and SEE Yahuah in it?

Ans. Gen 21:22

Gen 21:22 And it came to pass at that time, that **Abimelech** and **Phichol** the chief captain of his host **spake** unto **Abraham**, Saying, **YAHUAH is with thee** in all that thou doest...

'Elohim/Yahuah WITH US to HELP'

I urge upon you the necessity to LEARN & MEMORIZE

Psalm 91 esp. vs.1, and see the importance to Shema it/HEAR & DO!

2Chron.15:2 And he went out to meet Asa, and said unto him, **Shema** ye me, Asa, and **ALL Judah** and **Benjamin; Yahuah** *is with you, while* ye be **with him**; and **IF** ye **seek Him** (**w/ All your heart – Jer.29:13,14**), He will be found of you; **BUT IF** ye **forsake Him**, He will **forsake you**.

Jer 29:13 And ye shall **seek me**, and **find me**, **WHEN** ye shall search for me with all your heart. **Jer 29:14** And **I will be found of you**, saith **Yahuah**: and **I will turn away your captivity**, and **I will gather you from all the nations**, and from all the places whither I have driven you, saith **Yahuah**; and **I will bring you again** into the place whence I caused you to be carried away captive.

BEST promise – re: the **time of trouble -Psalm 91**

Great Blessing – to me – many times

Focus – verse 1

***Ps.91:1** He that **dwelleth**^{H3427} **in the secret place** `of the most High' shall **abide** `under the **shadow** of - **Almighty**.'

I want us to follow the admonition of David when he said, **`O MAGNIFY Yahuah** with me, and let us **exalt His name together. Ps.34:3**

There are 2 ways to MAGNIFY things either by using a Microscope or a Telescope.

A Microscope makes small objects appear bigger than they are.

A Telescope takes objects that are far off and brings them

closer so we can see them more nearly as they are.

I want us to use the **TELESCOPE of SCRIPTURE** to view Ps.91

[**Read thru Psalm 91 – IF time allows or certain selections**]

Psa 91:1 He/She that dwelleth in the secret place of the **most High** shall abide under the shadow of the **Almighty**.

Psa 91:2 I will say of **Yahuah**, *He is* my **refuge** and my **fortress**: my **Yahuah**; in him will I trust.

Psa 91:3 **Surely** he shall **deliver** thee from the snare of the fowler, *and* from the noisome pestilence.

Psa 91:4 He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth *shall be thy* shield and buckler.

Psa 91:5 Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; *nor* for the arrow *that* flieth by day;

Psa 91:6 *Nor* for the pestilence *that* walketh in darkness; *nor* for the destruction *that* wasteth at noonday.

Psa 91:7 A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; *but* it shall not come nigh thee.

Psa 91:8 Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the **reward of the wicked**.

Psa 91:9 BECAUSE thou hast made **Yahuah**, *which is* my refuge, *even* the **most High, thy habitation**;

Psa 91:10 There shall NO EVIL befall thee, **NEITHER shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling**.

(**REMEMBER EGYPT?**)

Psa 91:11 For he shall give **His angels** charge over thee, to

keep thee in all thy ways.

Psa 91:12 They shall bear thee up in *their* hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone.

Psa 91:13 Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.

Psa 91:14 BECAUSE he hath set his love upon me, **THEREFORE will I DELIVER him: I will set him on high, BECAUSE** he hath known my name.

Psa 91:15 He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him. (Like- Daniel)

Psa 91:16 With long life **will I** satisfy him, and shew him my (**Yahusha**) salvation!

To DWELL

H3427 יָשַׁב ya^ˆshab A **primitive root**; properly to *sit* down; by implication to **dwell**, to **remain**; causatively to **settle**, to *marry*: - (make to) **abide** (-ing), continue, (cause to, make to) **dwell** (-ing), **ease self**, endure, establish, X fail, habitation, haunt, (make to) inhabit (-ant),

'Who would, after seeking the King's Palace, be content to stand in the door(way), when he is invited in to dwell in the King's PRESENCE, and share with Him in all the glory of His Royal life? O Let us enter in and ABIDE, and enjoy to the full all the rich supply His wondrous love hath prepared for us!'
Abide In Christ pp.13,14

Q.7 IF Yahuah's creatures can find a dwelling can't you?

Ps.84:3 Yea, the sparrow hath found an **house**, and the swallow a **nest** for herself, where she may lay her young, *even* **thine altars**, O **Yahuah** of hosts, my King, and my **Elohim**.

Ps.91:1 He that **dwelleth in the secret place** 'of the most High' shall **abide** 'under the **shadow** of the **Almighty**.'

Abide

H3885 לִין לִין lu^n lîyn loon, leen

A **primitive root**; to **stop** (usually over night); by implication to **stay permanently**; hence (in a bad sense) to be *obstinate* (especially in words, to *complain*): - **abide** (all night), **continue**, dwell, **endure**, grudge, be left, lie all night, (cause to) **lodge** (all night, in, -ing, this night), (make to) murmur, **remain**, tarry (all night, that night).

Q.8 Did Yahusha speak about ABIDING?

Ans. John 15:1-7 (If pressed for time start at v.4)

John 15:1 I am the **true vine**, and my Father is the husbandman.

John 15:2 **Every branch in me** that beareth not fruit he taketh away: **and every branch that beareth fruit, he purgeth it**, that it may bring forth more fruit.

John 15:3 Now ye are clean through the word which I have spoken unto you.

John 15:4 **ABIDE in me**, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself, except it abide in the vine; no more can ye, **except ye ABIDE in me**.

John 15:5 **I am the VINE**, ye *are* the branches: He that abideth in me, and I in him, the same bringeth forth much fruit: for **WITHOUT me ye can do NOTHING**.

John 15:6 **IF** a man **ABIDE NOT in me**, he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered; and men gather them, and cast *them* into the fire, and they are burned.

John 15:7 **IF** ye **ABIDE in me**, and **my words ABIDE in you**, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you.

Q.9 Who or What is the Secret Place?

Ans. Ps.91:1

The Secret Place

Ps.91:1 He that **DWELLETH in the secret place** 'of the most High' shall **ABIDE** 'under the **shadow** of the **Almighty**.'

H5643 סֵתֶר סִתְרָה se^ther sithra^h say'-ther, sith-raw'
From **H5641**; a **cover** (in a good or a bad, a literal or a figurative sense): - backbiting, **covering**, covert, X disguise [-th], **hiding place**, privily, **protection**, secret (-ly, place).

Mat 23:37 O Jerusalem, Jerusalem, *thou* that killest the prophets, and stonest them which are sent unto thee, **how often would I have gathered thy children together, even as a hen gathereth her chickens under her wings, and ye would NOT!** Also **Luke 13:34**

Ps.17:8 Keep me as the apple of the eye, **hide me under the shadow of thy wings.** Shadow/ wings

H6738 צֶל tse^l tsale From H6751; *shade*, whether lit. or fig.: - defence, shade (-ow). **Total KJV occurrences:49**

Q.10 What do a few of the Psalms tell us?

Ps.32:7 **Thou** *art* **my hiding place**; thou shalt preserve me from trouble; thou shalt compass me about with songs of deliverance. Selah. THOU/hiding place

Ps.119:114 **Thou** *art* **my hiding place** and my shield: I hope in thy word. **Thou/hiding place**

Ps.143:9 **Deliver** me, O **Yahuah**, from mine enemies: I flee unto **thee** to **hide me**. **Thee/hid**

Ps.27:5 For **in the time of trouble** **He shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of His tabernacle (where He abides)** shall **He hide me;** **He shall set me up upon a rock.**

Ps.31:20 **Thou shalt hide them in the secret of thy presence*** from the pride of man: **thou shalt keep them secretly in a pavilion** from the strife of tongues. Secret/ Presence, pavilion

Q.11 What does Isaih tell us?

Ans. Isa 26:20

Isa 26:20 **Come**, my people, **enter** thou into thy chambers, **and shut thy doors about thee: hide thyself** as it were for a little moment, **until the indignation be overpast!**

Closing:

Exo 25:8 And let them make me a sanctuary; that I may dwell among them.

YAHUAH'S ABIDING Place is the HEART of His people.

Do YOU want Yahuah to ABIDE in YOUR Heart?
