

## Second Advent #10

Did you know that for every prophecy in the 1<sup>st</sup> Testament about the 1<sup>st</sup> coming of Yahusha that there are eight prophecies in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Testament? Scripture mentions Yahusha's return over 1,500 times. The return of Yahusha is mentioned in every five verses in the 2<sup>nd</sup> Testament. That's how important it is. It was a favorite theme of Yahusha and He spoke of it quite often. In today's lesson we will explore what Scripture has to teach about this INCREDIBLE event: the return of Yahusha.

**Q.1** What promise did Yahusha give His disciples concerning this event?

**Ans.** John 14:1-3

**John 14:1** Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in Yahuah, believe also in me.

**John 14:2** In my Father's house are many mansions: if *it were not so*, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you.

**John 14:3** And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, ye may be also.

**Q.2** What did Yahusha say He would do when He returns?

**Ans.** Matthew 16:27

**Mat 16:27** For the Son of man shall come in the glory of his Father with his angels; and then he shall reward every man according to his works.

**Q.3** In what manner does Scripture teach regarding Yahusha's return?

**Ans.** Rev.1:7, Acts 1:9-11

**Rev 1:7** Behold, he cometh with clouds; and every eye shall see him, and they *also* which pierced him: and all kindreds of the earth shall wail because of him. Even so, Amen.

**Acts 1:9** And when he had spoken these things, while they beheld, he was taken up; and a cloud received him out of their sight.

**Acts 1:10** And while they looked steadfastly toward heaven as he went up, behold, two men stood by them in white

apparel;

**Acts**

**1:11** Which also said, Ye men of Galilee, why stand ye gazing up into heaven? this same Yahusha, which is taken up from you into heaven, shall so come in like manner as ye have seen him go into heaven.

**Q.4** Will His coming be a secret and silent event?

**Ans.** Psalm 50:3,4

**Ps.50:3** Our Aluahim shall come, and shall not keep silence: a fire shall devour before him, and it shall be very tempestuous round about him.

**Ps.50:4** He shall call to the heavens from above, and to the earth, that he may judge his people.

**Note:** His coming will NOT be in secret. Scripture teaches that everyone will know that this climactic event is taking place. It will be a very real, visible and audible event.

**Q.5** What will the angels be doing at this time?

**Ans.** Matthew 24:30,31; 25:31

**Mat 24:30** And then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven: and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn, and they shall see the Son of man coming in the

**clouds of heaven with power and great glory.**

**Mat 24:31** And he shall send his angels with a great sound of a trumpet, and they shall gather together his elect from the four winds, from one end of heaven to the other.

**Mat 25:31** When the Son of man shall come in his glory, and all the holy angels with him, then shall he sit upon the throne of his glory:

Note: When just one angel rolled back the stone from Yahusha's tomb, the Roman soldiers fell like dead men, dazed by the angel's countenance, which was 'like lightening' (See Mt.28:2,3). Think of the splendor of 'ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands of angels coming with Yahusha? (See Rev.5:11)

**Q.6** What will happen to those 'in Yahusha' at His coming? **Ans.** 1 Thes.4:16,17

**1Thes 4:16** For YaHUaH himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of Aluahim: and the dead in Messiah shall rise first:

**1Thes 4:17** Then we which are alive *and* remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet YaHUaH in the air: and so shall we ever be with YaHUaH.

**Q.7** What will happen to those 'NOT in Yahusha'?  
**Ans.** Rev.6:15-17

**Rev 6:15** And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid

**themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains;**

**Rev 6:16 And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the**

**Lamb: Rev 6:17 For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand?**

**Note: This is one of the saddest pictures in ALL of Scripture – people who deliberately and continually reject the One who loves them so. They finally realize that they are lost. How sad when it could have been different.**

**Q.8 What will happen to our bodies when Yahusha returns? Ans. 1 Cor.15:51-54**

**1Cor 15:51 Behold, I shew you a mystery; We shall not all sleep, but we shall all be changed,**

**1Cor 15:52 In a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trump: for the trumpet shall sound, and the dead shall be raised incorruptible, and we shall be changed. 1Cor 15:53 For**

**this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal *must* put on immortality. 1Cor 15:54 So**

**when this corruptible shall have put on incorruption, and this mortal shall have put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written, Death is swallowed up in victory.**

**Q.9 Does Yahuah take pleasure in the death of the wicked? Ans. Ez.18:32; 33:11**

**Eze 18:31 Cast away from you all your transgressions, whereby ye have transgressed; and make you a new heart and a new spirit: for why will ye die, O house of Israel?**

**Eze 18:32 For I have no pleasure in the death of him that dieth, saith Yahuah Aluahim: wherefore turn *yourselves*, and live ye.**

**Eze 33:11 Say unto them, *As I live*, saith Yahuah Aluahim, I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked; but that the wicked turn from his way and live: turn ye, turn ye from your evil ways; for why will ye die, O house of Israel?**

**Conclusion: The second coming of Yahusha will NOT be a secret event, but the most INCREDIBLE event that the world has ever seen. For some it will be a most wonderful event, BUT, for others it will be the most terrifying. YaHUaH wants us ALL to be in heaven with Him, but He cannot force those who refuse Him. And He cannot bring those along who don't want to be there. Never again can He risk the harmony of heaven.**
