

The Believers Source of Power #6

In Mt.5:20 Yahusha said, 'That unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisee's and the teachers of Torah, you will certainly not enter into the kingdom of heaven.' What type of righteousness was he talking? Can we obey on our own? What about our personal struggles with sin?

Yahusha was the epitome of righteousness on this earth. He lived a perfect life for you and me. If we want to discover what Yahusha meant by this we must first study how Yahusha lived His life. What was the source of His power?

Q.1 Was Yahusha made like us in every way? Ans. Hebrews 2:14-18, 10:12

Note: Yahusha became like one of us. He had struggles and temptations. He got hungry, thirsty and tired. He had to become like us in order for Him to qualify as our Savior, and second Adam. He became like us to be an example for us in every way.

Q.2 If Yahusha was like us in every way how did He perform the miracles He did and live obediently in every way? Ans. John 5:19; 6:57; 8:28; 14:8-11; 10:30-33

Note: Yahusha was in close connection with the Father (Yahuah) and it was through this close union that the Father was able to work through Yahusha. Yahusha was completely dependent upon His Father in all things. The miracles, the healings, the teachings were all through the Father. Yahusha became man and depended upon heaven for His strength.

Q.3 How does this principle with union with the Father apply to us? Ans. John 15:1-8

Note: If we abide in Yahusha then Yahusha lives within us.

Q.4 How did Yahusha maintain a vital connection with the Father? Ans. Mark 1:35

Q.5 What type of prayers did Yahusha pray? Ans. Matthew 26:39; John 6:38

Note: Yahusha is our example in all things. Yahusha was surrendered to the Father. So are we to be surrendered to Yahusha.

To abide in Yahusha is to allow His words to abide in you!

In His analysis to live like a believer, Yahusha makes it abundantly clear what it really means to be united with him. John 15:7

To abide in Yahusha means that His word, His teachings His life-giving principles fill your mind and transform your life. Yahuah's words contain life-giving power. This is the connection to the source of power in your life.

Q.9 Some read Yahuah's word and receive little benefit. Why? Ans. Hebrew 4:2

Note: There are over 3,573 promises or cluster of promises in Scripture. They are assurances from a loving heavenly Father of His care and concern. Acceptance of the promises by faith bring a peace (Shalum) and calm to your life.

Q.10 Without Yahusha what can we do on our own? Ans. John 15:5

Q.11 With Yahusha what can we do? Ans. Philippians 4:13

Q.12 What is the purpose of Yahusha's righteousness in us? Ans. John 15:8; Psalm 23:3; Isaiah 61:3; Philippians 1:11

Conclusion: Just as a baby must receive nourishment from the mother's umbilical cord, so, we to, must receive nourishment through our vital connection with Yahuah. Without it we are powerless in our battle with evil. Without it we are helpless in our struggle with temptations and sin. Our works do NOT save us BUT they are the evidence of genuine faith in Yahuah in our lives. And they are instrumental in leading others to Yahusha and Salvation!
